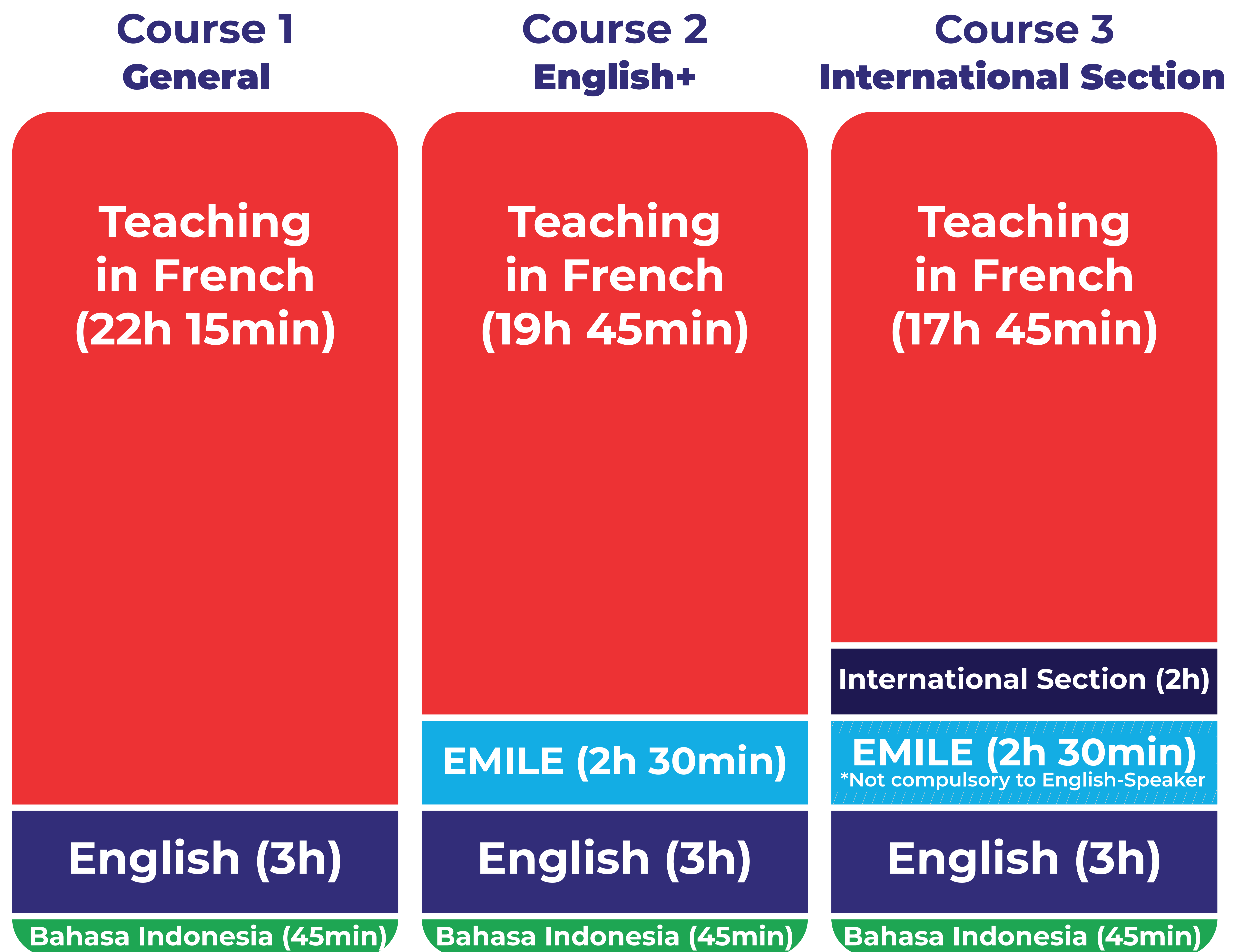


ELEMENTARY Linguistic Pathways



Bridging Program (French beginners)



- General : Core subjects being taught in French (including 10 hours of French language for foreign students.)
- ✳ EMILE : Some elements of the curriculum subjects being taught in English (Geometry, Geography, Arts, Sports...)
- International Section : Teachers that teach in the North American style. Children are learning about History, Geography, Literature and Culture from English speaking countries.
Requested 85% success rate on Cambridge tests
- English : Teaching of the English language
- Bahasa Indonesia : Teaching of the Indonesian language
- Bridging Program : for new non-French-speaking students who speak English, to facilitate their adaptation to the school. On arrival, they participate in the maximum possible number of classes offered in English (bilingual in Preschool or SI course in Elementary), then gradually reduce the amount of time spent in English until maximum exposure to French in the “Général Track”.
