Responsibilities

- Contribute to the development and implementation of the secondary school language pathway for English.
- Assess and track student progress and provide regular feedback.
- Adapt teaching approaches to support students with specific educational needs.
- Maintain regular communication with families and support students in their academic orientation (parent-teacher meetings, individual appointments, etc.).
- Work collaboratively with colleagues and contribute to the school community.
- Participate in school meetings and projects.
- Take an active role in school life and help promote cultural and language events.
